Gabriela Gimenes possui um Doutoramento em Música pela University of North Texas, um Mestrado em Música pela University of Central Arkansas e uma Licenciatura em Música pela Universidade Estadual de São Paulo. Ela atuou como professora adjunta na University of Mobile, Harding University e Brookhaven College, além de ter ocupado o cargo de coordenadora do Departamento de Música Online na Universidade Metropolitana de Santos. Sua experiência de performance inclui participação na Conway Symphony Orchestra, na Orquestra Acadêmica do Estado de São Paulo e na produção de "Fiddler on the Roof" e substituta no Wicked em São Paulo, Brasil. Gabriela também atuou como flautista substituta na Arkansas Symphony Orchestra. Gabriela foi vencedora da Competição MTNA de Arkansas 2004-2005 a nível estadual e recebeu uma menção

She has served as an adjunct professor at the University of Mobile, Harding University, and Brookhaven College, and has held the position of Chair of the Online Music Department at Universidade Metropolitana de Santos. Her performance experience includes playing with the Conway Symphony Orchestra, the Orquestra Acadêmica do Estado de São Paulo, and participating in the production of "Fiddler on the Roof" as well as substitute at the Wicked production in São Paulo, Brazil. Gabriela also served as a flute substitute for the Arkansas Symphony Orchestra. In recognition of her achievements, she won the Arkansas 2004-2005 MTNA Competition at the state level and received an honorable mention at the



Natural de Houston, nos Estados Unidos, a flautista coreano-americana Julee Kim Walker é Professora de Flauta e Vice-Diretora da Escola de Música da East Texas A&M University, perto de Dallas, no Texas, onde leciona desde 2012. Artista da Haynes Flutes, é uma intérprete ativa, educadora musical apaixonada, pedagoga dedicada, mentora e gestora cultural. Professora respeitada, a Dra. Walker recebeu duas vezes o Prêmio Paul W. Barrus para Excelência no Ensino na ETAMU, sendo frequentemente convidada como orientadora de masterclasses, jurada e conferencista em todo o mundo, incluindo na University of North Texas, CU Boulder, Universidade de Xangai (China), a masterclass de verão de Raffaele Trevisani em Itália e a Universidade Estadual de São Paulo (Brasil). Apresentou-se também na Áustria, Itália, França, Croácia, Chile, Brasil, Argentina e China.

A Dra. Walker atua regularmente com o trio FlutAtrial e com diversos ensembles na área metropolitana de Dallas-Fort Worth, como a Fort Worth Symphony, Piano Symphony e

A native Houstonian, Korean-American flutist Julee Kim Walker is Professor of Flute and Assistant Head of the School of Music at East Texas A&M University near Dallas, TX, where she has taught since 2012. A Haynes Flute Artist, she is an active performer, passionate music educator & pedagogue, and a dedicated mentor & arts administrator. An esteemed teacher, Dr. Walker was twice the recipient of the Paul W. Barrus Distinguished Faculty Award for Teaching at ETAMU, and is sought-after as a clinician, adjudicator, and masterclasses teacher and lecturer all over the world, to include University of North Texas, CU Boulder, Shanghai Normal University in China, the Raffaele Trevisani Summer Masterclass in Italy, and São Paulo State University in Brazil. She has also performed in Austria, Italy, France, Croatia, Chile, Brazil, Argentina and China. Dr. Walker performs regularly with FlutAtrial trio and with several ensembles in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex such as the Fort Worth Symphony, Piano Symphony and Irving Symphony, and has also performed with Dallas Symphony

Irving Symphony. Também já se apresentou com a Dallas Symphony Orchestra, The Dallas Winds, The Dallas Opera, New Orchestra of Washington, Fort Worth Opera, Dallas Chamber Symphony e Dallas Theater Center. Como solista, atuou com agrupamentos como a Dallas Asian Winds, American Wind Symphony Orchestra, Southeastern Symphonic Winds, East Texas A&M University Wind Ensemble e a Banda Sinfônica de Cubatão (Brasil). Julee já integrou a Direção da National Flute Association como Secretária e Secretária-Adjunta, e também foi Presidente e Vice-Presidente da Texas Flute Society. É Diretora Artística do Texas Summer Flute Symposium, que se realiza todos os verões em Commerce, Texas, e lidera um programa de mentoría de carreira individual e oficinas para universidades. Obteve a licenciatura em música na University of Texas at Austin, o mestrado na San Francisco Conservatory of Music, e o doutoramento na University of North Texas. Estudou com September Payne, Christina Jennings, Karl Kraber, Timothy Day e Terri Sundberg.

She received her Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Texas at Austin, her Master's degree from the San Francisco Conservatory of Music, and the Doctorate of Musical Arts degree from the University of North Texas. Her principal teachers were September Payne, Christina Jennings, Karl Kraber, Timothy Day and Terri Sundberg.



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
